

PROJECT 50 ANOTHER PENTECOST

Thank you for reviewing the Target Cities of the South Central Texas District, UPCI!

Our vision with Project 50 is to see "Another Pentecost." Pentecost is a transliteration of the Greek word *pentekostes* which means 50. Project 50 is a 36-month plan to establish 30 preaching points, 10 daughter works, and 10 self-governing works. This booklet shows you the current works in each section and the target cities identified for expansion by each presbyter.

Matthew 9:35-38 (KJV) tells us, "And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the laborers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth laborers into his harvest."

Many cities within our South Central Texas District have populations greater than 3,000 people and smaller communities that do not have an apostolic church. May the information and direction within this booklet be the foundation for praying, planning, preparing, and planting in these areas. God move us with compassion! Not just moved emotionally but moved into faith-filled action! Let us launch out into the deep for a netbreaking, boat-sinking revival!

Here are some practical steps we can take with the information provided in this booklet:

1. PRAY: Pray for the Target Cities. Pray for revelation and receptivity to the gospel. Pray for open doors. Pray against principalities, powers, rulers of the darkness, and wickedness in high places. Pray to break strongholds. Pray for light to break forth into the darkness. Pray for God to send laborers into His harvest. Pray for open doors and key connections. Pray for a divine strategy to reach each community. 2. PLAN: Work with the plans laid out by each sectional presbyter and NAM director. Make plans to expand to neighboring communities and unreached people groups within each city. Set a goal and put a date on it. Identify potential leaders for church planting. Visit http://sctxupci.com/nam/ and familiarize yourself with the NAM process for starting Home Bible Studies, preaching points, and daughter works. Communicate your desire to plant a new work to your local, sectional, and district leadership.

3. PREPARE: Avail yourself of every training opportunity related to our mission. Train up leaders to be sent out (www.ministrycentral.com). Utilize materials available through the downloadable resources at www.upciministers.com. Strategic Growth Initiative (SGI) materials and resources found there give specific direction on planting churches. Gather resources for future expansion.

4. PLANT: Start planting seeds of faith with a prayer walk, a prayer meeting, a Bible study, a preaching point, or a daughterwork.

"He that observeth the wind shall not sow; and he that regardeth the clouds shall not reap" (Ecclesiastes 11:4).

A perfect season will never present itself, but the faithful must move forward despite the present challenges. May the Lord give us favor in the field!
